

Available Sessions

Littleleaps is open between 7.30am and 5.30pm Monday to Friday

Fees are calculated on an hourly rate

Long day sessions, 9 hours or more are calculated at a discounted hourly rate

Sessions can start between 7.30am and 9.00am or at 1pm Sessions can end at 1.00pm or between 4.00pm and 5.30pm

Littleleaps sessions aim to offer flexibility to meet the needs of parents and children alike

Children arriving at or before 8.30am will be offered breakfast

Lunch is served between 12-1pm Nursery hot lunches can be booked for an extra fee alternatively, parents can provide a packed lunch

> Tea is served at 4pm Parents can provide a packed tea

Children are given accessibility to their drink throughout their session Snack and milk/water will be offered at 10am & 2pm

Fees are calculated calendar monthly based on a regular booking pattern – we **do not** charge for bank holidays, Christmas Eve and the week between Christmas and New Year when the nursery is closed

The sessions and fee information are to be read in conjunction with our terms and conditions. Should you have any questions please speak to a member of management.

Sessions require a regular booking pattern each week. (A regular booking pattern is the same sessions every week). Regular booking patterns and any additional sessions added to a regular booking pattern are subject to availability. For children accessing a place without 2 or 3 year old government funding,

Government funding is intended to cover the cost to deliver 15/12 or 30/24 hours a week of free, high quality, flexible childcare. It is not intended to cover the cost of meals, consumables, additional hours, or additional services. Government funded hours can be used between the hours of 8am-5pm, any additional hours used before 8am, after 5pm or that exceed the number of government funded hours available will be calculated on a fixed hourly rate for

funded children. Children in receipt of government funding will be charged for snack/consumables. These fees are current from April 2023.
